Success in business can easily lead to a presumptuous feeling of absolute ownership and the desire for more, often regardless of the right and needs of others. The Bible reminds us that there is no such a thing as absolute ownership. Humankind is God's partner and with God is responsible for better world. In partnership with God, humankind has the right to use the resources of the planet. Therefore everyone must be guaranteed a fair share in their ownership. Historical and sociological considerations indicate that the most practical means of insuring everyone's access to the goods of the earth is some system of private property. The right of private property is derived from the collective right of the human race to use the goods of the earth. "To each his/her own" is the golden rule of justice. Workers are entitled to earn a just wage and to receive humane treatment, and they must do a good job. We have our unions to protect these rights.
