How tenacious is that inborn instinct in all of us to go on living even after this life comes to an end. Parents want to live on in their children. A father wants at least one of his sons to continue the business that he has founded. Ex-presidents and former prime ministers found memorial libraries and write memoirs. We do not want oblivion. How do we survive? In the memory of my beloved ones, I will live on as the person they have known. In God, I will live on as the person I am. For God there is no hidden aspect of my character, as there possibly could have been for those who loved me.
