Any time we read that our armed forces are in a state of alert somewhere in the world, we know that there is a threat to our security. Alertness is good and necessary. When the IRS is about to check our files, we are alert and check first! Quite a few disasters, explosions, and fires could have been prevented if those in charge would have been as alert as they should have. Persons chosen to high office must submit themselves to scrutiny. If they been have honest, they can open their books fearlessly. Such people have been on the alert all their lives and they have no need to fear the day of scrutiny. A concept found in the Bible time and again is that of “Day of the Lord”. It is a day of darkness and fear, a day of wrath and destruction. God will intervene in favor of the righteous, and punish the wicked. Gradually, “That Day” in the perspective of the prophets is delayed to the end-time. In New Testament “That Day” is connected with Jesus Christ’s second coming to judge the living and the dead. When the “Day of the Lord” is mentioned, a warning to be alert goes with it. The Lord could come at a moment you least expect!
