Wherever people are “one”, in other words, establish a group, be it a garden club, a sorority, a fraternity, or the family, we may ask: “What motivates such people to come together and stay together?” Bypassing business concerns, we can pinpoint mutual interests and various levels of friendship and love. There is loyalty to the group and a body charged with the administrative and executive work.

The group charged by our Lord to establish God’s reign on earth, and though marred by human deficiencies still together after 2000 years, evokes the same question: “What motivates Christians to come together and stay together?” Today’s liturgy dwells upon this question. As a Christian dedicated to establishing God’s reign of love and justice in and around you, you may have doubts about the way groups are organized. A prayerful reading of today’s Scripture may help you.

Questions for reflection

- Under what circumstances does the number in that circle change?

- How has love proved its endurance in your life?

- How can you give this gift to others?
