1. The rite of blessing of the empty tomb and the opening prayers will begin today`s liturgy; all are asked to KNEEL.
2. The procession will take place inside the church; the following order is to be followed: Processional Cross and symbols of the Resurrection: lighted Paschal Candle, Adorational Cross and Statue of the Risen Lord.
3. US, Polish and PNCC flags, Altar Server, ANS Society, flower girls Celebrant and Assistants.
4. During the procession all STAND and join the Choir in singing.

Thanks to all of you who helped to decorate the church, helped during Holy Week and Resurrection services and processions, and those who attended. Special thanks to our Music Minister Dawn Wassman and our Choir. May Jesus` Resurrection bring you many blessings! ALLELUIA!
