The first thing our parents taught us about our religion was most probably the sign of the cross. The last thing a priest will do at our graveside is making the sign of the cross over our body. A Christian's life is marked "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit".

The revelation of God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit tell us first of all what God is for us. But as to the mysterious unity of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, we can only stammer with inadequate human concepts, which are not able to express the ineffable mystery of God in him. Human beings want to know. But we must realize that more important than knowing about God is knowing God, the way two beloved know one another! An intimate person-to-person relationship gives a knowledge, which cannot possibly be expressed in human terminology. It is that kind of knowledge of God, which ultimately satisfies a human being. "How deep are the riches and the wisdom and the knowledge of God! How inscrutable his judgments, how unreachable his ways.

Questions for reflection

"Ask now of the days of old, before your time, ever since God created us upon the earth; ask from one end of the sky to the other: Did anything so great ever happen before?"

- Name three ways you have become aware of God's presence or action in your life. What are the characteristics of God revealed in all three?

The Spirit bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ.

- At what times does God seem close and familiar to you?
- Is there ever a time when God seems distant or strange?

And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." Name ten ways God has shown love for you.

- Now think of two ways you can love God back before the end of the day.
